



2022 Youth National Championship
Safety and Security Rules Revision (8/17/22)

- Metal detectors or metal detecting wands will be used to screen all adult spectators at all YNC events. Event venues are gun free zones.
- Increased police coverage at all YNC events.
- Clear bag policy will be enforced for all spectators, players, and coaches/volunteers.
- All canopies must be carried in by hand without canopy bag.
- No pull in wagons will be allowed in the venues.
- Coolers and snack bags must be carried in by hand and are subject to be searched.
- Chains and down markers will be run by official event employees. (Volunteers or parents will not be allowed going forward.)
- There will be no exception to the number of sideline people (per team) with access. This number has been set at (8) eight for the preseason and (10) ten at Nationals.
- All media access must be approved 48 hours before the event begins with official media verification. (YouTube page, website, business license, etc.) No same day request will be honored going forward.
- All Coaches will have to complete a background check for field access at Nationals. Background check results will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- Zero tolerance for verbal or physical misconduct towards referees and event staff. (This applies to all spectators, coaches, players, and volunteers.)
 - Misconduct towards refs or event staff will result in ejection from the game and removal from the facility.
 - If an ejected person refuses to leave the facility the game will be forfeited.
- Zero tolerance for physical altercations at any youth event across all youth sports platforms YNC related or non YNC related. Offenders will be banned entry into YNC facility.
